

MAKE A GHOSTLY FLASHLIGHT SILHOUETTE SCENE

*Kids, ask a grown-up for help!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

Sturdy paper
Pencil
Flashlight
Tape or glue
Black construction paper
Wooden craft stick (optional)
Scissors*

DIRECTIONS

1. Print these sheets on sturdy paper, such as cardstock (if possible).
2. Tape or glue the background scene to the back of a cereal box. If you don't have a box, find another way to prop up the paper.
3. Cut out the Gooigi, Polterpup, and Luigi figures along the dotted lines. Fold in the solid lines below each figure, then use tape or glue to attach the gray "GLUE" tab to the back to make the paper figure stand up.
4. Tape or paste the ghost cutouts to the background scene, then stand the characters in front of the scene.
5. Cut out along the dotted lines the two square boxes with the ghosts inside. Then, starting at the dotted line below the ghost, carefully cut out the ghost shapes.
6. Using the square boxes as stencils, trace the outline of each box and the ghost shape inside on black construction paper.
7. Cut out the black squares and the ghost shapes inside.
8. Turn out the lights, hold the square cutout up to a flashlight, and adjust the distance until a spooky ghost silhouette appears on the background scene. EEEEEK!!!! If you want, you can tape or paste the square cutout to a wooden craft stick to help hold it up in front of the flashlight.
