

Backpack Gamer Tags



What you'll need:

- Sturdy paper, such as card stock
- Pen or pencil
- Ribbon or string
- Hole punch (optional)
- Laminating sheet (optional)
- Scissors*

*Kids, ask a grown-up to help with scissors!

Instructions:

- 1 Print tag on sturdy paper.
- 2 Carefully cut along the dotted line.
- 3 Fold the tag horizontally along the solid line.
- 4 Fill out the tag.
- 5 Laminate the tag (optional).
- 6 Punch out the hole and run a ribbon or string through it.
- 7 Tie the tag to your backpack!

Note: You can also print this sheet on regular paper and use tape to attach the labels to your lunchbox or pencil case.



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
