

# Mushroom Kingdom Snow Globe



## What you'll need:


Paper (sturdy paper recommended)  
Glue stick  
Cotton balls (optional)  
Scissors\*  
*\*Kids, ask a grown-up to help with scissors!*

## Instructions:



1. Choose the character combination you'd like to use and cut out that piece.
2. Carefully cut out the snow globe piece and two base pieces along the solid lines. You may need a grown-up to help cut out the inner circle piece and around the small tabs.
3. First, create the snow globe. Glue the character combo piece to the blank side of the solid circle snow globe piece.
4. Take the snow globe piece and fold back the solid circle piece and the cut-out circle piece along the solid lines.
5. Fold the eight small PASTE tabs at the solid lines.
6. Take the ends of the long strip and form a circle, then tape or glue the PASTE tab on one end of the long strip to the other end. Glue the tabs to the back of the circles where indicated.
7. Next, create the base. Take the two base pieces and fold back the PASTE tabs and BOTTOM tab, then assemble and paste.
8. If you'd like, you can place cotton balls in the snow globe for an added wintery touch.
9. You can place your snow globe in the base and display during the holidays!
